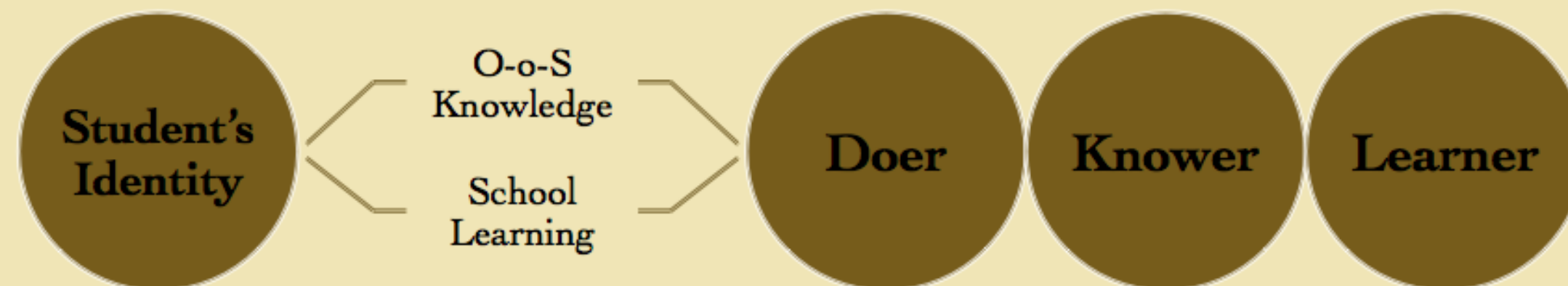
Funds of Knowledge

Children in low income neighbourhoods are often immersed in social relationships and work practices from an early age which contain knowledge resources and cultural insights, known as **funds of knowledge**.



Funds of knowledge make an individual or a group independent, avoiding reliance or dependence on experts or specialists. It builds a resource pool of different skills and practices, specially in situations where people change jobs frequently.
